SIGNS OF SUICIDE

The Student Services team is offering depression awareness and suicide prevention education as part of the SOS Signs of Suicide® Prevention Program. The program encourages students to seek help if they are concerned about themselves or a friend. The SOS Program is the only youth suicide prevention program that has demonstrated an improvement in students' knowledge and adaptive attitudes about suicide risk and depression, as well as a reduction in actual suicide attempts. This lesson will be given to our 8th grade students during their Health and P.E. classes the week of the 16th. We hope to equip all 339 students with the knowledge and tools to recognize signs of distress in themselves and others, fostering a supportive and empathic community.
